WAGE EXEMPTION: This Writ does not attach any wages or salary owed by you to an employee.

In your Notice of Response you may dispute your liability to pay into Court all or part of the amount sought to be attached. (A Notice of Response must be filed and delivered

# What do forms do?

What do forms constrain? Where do they convey their information/meaning?

# 3 A thing itself Key value: authenticity – using the right item

• The thing itself has special properties (inherent value or trustworthiness)

# Forms as means of communication



## Person to Government



Requiring a form can add to...

- Completeness and consistency of information
- Processing efficiency (e.g. machine readability)
- Easier data mining and recordkeeping



### Can also erect obstacles

"The Circomlocution Department is accessible to the Public if the Public approaches it according to the official forms; if the Public does not approach it according to the official forms, the Public has itself to blame."

#### Government to Person

A legislated form can...

 Control (and simplify) administrative action

- Enhance public confidence
- Aid interjurisdictional comity



OPC

Person to Person (neither = Government)

A required form can...

- Regularize legal relationships
- Help offset power imbalances
- Streamline dispute resolution



### Typology of Forms

- 1. A legislated form controls
  - a ritual text;
  - the presentation of information; or
  - the use of special documents.
- 2. A legislated form transmits information
  - from non-government persons to government;
  - from government to non-government persons; or
  - between non-government persons.

*Interpretation Acts* and deviations from forms

Where a form is prescribed, deviations therefrom not affecting the substance nor calculated to mislead, shall not invalidate the form used.

> RSNB 1973, c I-13, s 22(f); (same with minor variations in Canada, AB, BC, NL, NS, NT, NU, PE, SK, YT)

Where a form is prescribed, deviations therefrom not affecting the substance nor calculated to mislead, shall not invalidate the form used.

 What about a deviant form that's calculated to mislead, but couldn't possibly succeed? A form that differs from the one prescribed or approved under an Act or regulation may be validly used if the differences do not affect the substance and are not likely to mislead.

CCSM c I80, s 37

The strict use of the forms enacted by statutes to ensure the execution of their provisions shall not be required on pain of nullity, if the deviations therefrom do not affect the meaning.

CQLR c I-16, s 48

Deviations from a form whose use is required under an Act do not invalidate the form if,

(a) they do not affect the substance and are unlikely to mislead; and

(b) the form is organized in the same or substantially the same way as the form whose use is required.

#### So what?

#### A decision tree for legislative drafters

1. Should the legislation require use of a form?

- Is a form necessary?
  - Ritual text (e.g. oath)
  - Technical requirements
  - Authenticity
- Will a form be helpful...
  - to the client-user?
  - to the program administrator?

#### 2. Should the form itself be legislated?

Consistency – and legislative burden vs Flexibility – and potential uncertainty To apply for a grant, a school division must submit the prescribed form within a prescribed period to the Minister.

#### (g) Private

The plate's size shall be 152 x 304 mm (6" x 12") and have one of the following sets of distinguishing marks, colors, symbol, and size of lettering and digits:

- (i) Gold background, black letters and digits no larger than 67 mm (2 3/4") in height for the plate's identification marks, a goldpanner symbol on the left hand side of the plate, the words "The Klondike" no larger than 16 mm (5/8") in height on the top portion of the plate and the word "Yukon" no larger than 16 mm (5/8") in height on the bottom portion of the plate; or

- Does *Cabinet* need to make a form?
  - structure of enactment
  - contentious matter
- If not, consider delegating to Minister, program official (e.g. Registrar)

#### 5. What kind of form best fits the need?

- Which value(s) is (are) served?
  - Right words, right information, right thing?
- Where is information flowing?

- Q. What are legislated forms for?
- A. Control by the legislator of the words, the method or the document (thing).
